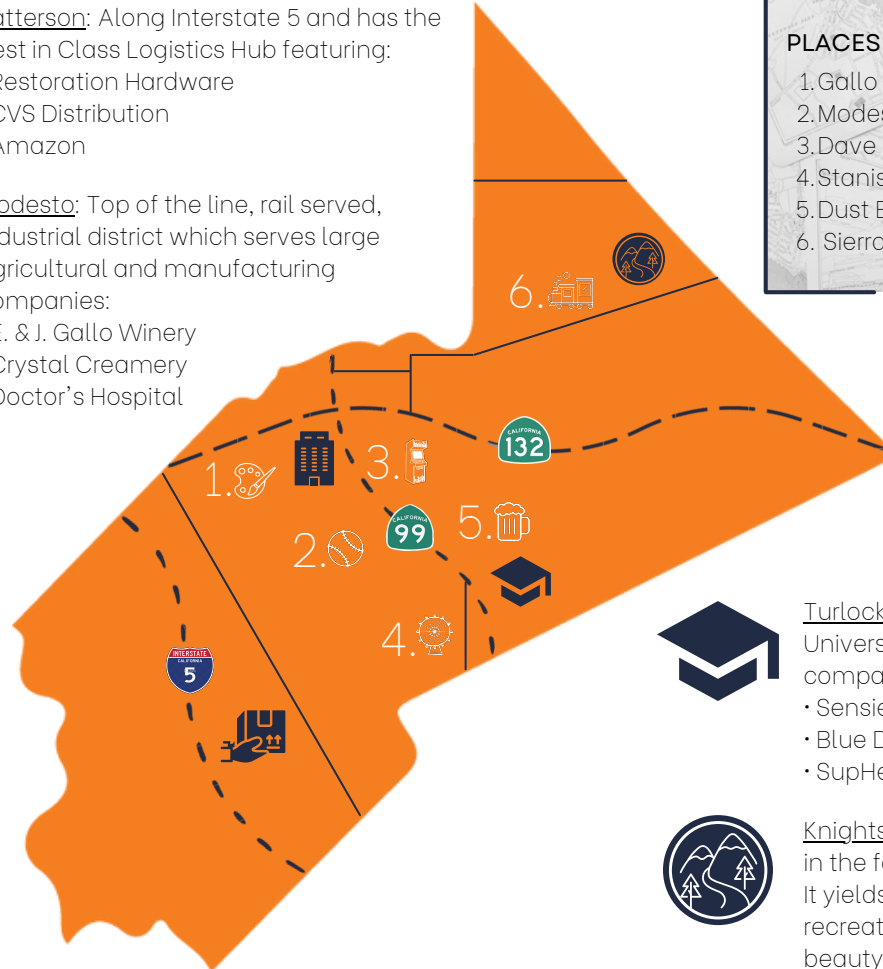
Patterson: Along Interstate 5 and has the Best in Class Logistics Hub featuring:
